Gender Equality Awards 2025

Equality between women and men is one of the guiding principles of the University of Regensburg. Since 2004, the University of Regensburg has been awarding the Gender Equality Awards to make achievements and progress in research and teaching visible in connection with the goal of actually implementing equal opportunities for women and men.

In 2025, awards will be given in two categories:

- 1. Outstanding projects in research, academic teaching, knowledge transfer or student initiatives with a focus on gender equality and with the aim of achieving equal opportunities. Group and collaborative projects are particularly encouraged as well as intersectional perspectives and inter-/transdisciplinary approaches. The prize money in category 1 is € 4.000,00.
- 2. Outstanding dissertations or habilitations conducted at the UR with a thematic and titular focus on Gender Studies and/or Women's Studies, and completed between 1 October 2023 and 30 September 2024. The prize money in category 2 is € 1.000,00.

Depending on the application situation, the award committee may decide to grant only one award of $\leq 5,000.00$.

Applications may be submitted by any member of the University of Regensburg. We encourage self-nominations. The deadline for applications is 1 July 2025. Contact: Anna Theresa Wolferstetter, Equal Opportunities Coordination Office.

Applications should be addressed to the University Representative for the Equality of Women in Academia and the Arts.

Please submit your application in one pdf file by email to the Equal Opportunities Coordination Office (chancengleichheit@ur.de) with the subject line "Submission for the Equal Opportunities Award 2025". The project description should not exceed five pages and should include details of how the prize money will be used, the contact person responsible for the application and their contact details. Applicants should also submit a curriculum vitae. It is possible to send CVs, publications and other documents in a second file. Category 2 applicants should additionally submit their doctoral or post-doctoral thesis (Promotions- oder Habilitationsschrift), together with an expert's report and a certificate or letter of endorsement from their Faculty.
