

## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR DEGREE-SEEKING B.A. STUDENTS

- **Additional Foreign Language Skills:**

Students in the B.A. programs American Studies, British Studies, and English Linguistics must show some proof of foreign language skills in addition to English by the time they apply for admission to their final thesis at the Examinations Office. The level must be at least A1 according to the CEFR. Additional foreign language skills may be acquired during the course of study.

- **Fundamentals and Orientation Exam** (Grundlagen- und Orientierungsprüfung):

At the end of the second semester, students in the B.A. programs American Studies, British Studies, and English Linguistics should be able to show proof of having completed at least the following mandatory courses / number of credit points in the core modules:

- major (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>): at least **20 ECTS credit points**, including *General Language Course A* (GLC A) + 3 introductory courses
- minor: at least **10 ECTS credit points**, including *General Language Course A* (GLC A) + 1 introductory course

NOTE: This is a **minimum requirement!** Ideally, courses of approximately 30 ECTS credit points (major) or 12-15 ECTS credit points (minor) should be successfully completed by the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

- **Language courses in the intermediate and advanced modules:**

- B.A. American Studies: Language courses in the intermediate and advanced modules should be taken with an American Studies instructor.
- B.A. British Studies: Language courses in the intermediate and advanced modules should be taken with a British Studies instructor.
- B.A. English Linguistics: Language courses in the intermediate and advanced modules may be taken with either a British Studies or an American Studies instructor.

- Course format: L = lecture (Vorlesung); S = seminar (Seminar)
- Language of instruction: Almost all courses at the Department of English and American Studies are taught in English. Courses taught in German are marked with <sup>G</sup> in the tables.
- Translation of module names into German:
  - CORE MODULE = Basismodul
  - INTERMEDIATE MODULE = Vertiefungsmodul
  - ADVANCED MODULE = Profilmodul
