### Dear students,

- You can fill out the applications on this homepage and sign them.
- The applications were created with Foxit PDF Editor, and can also be opened and edited with Adobe Acrobat Reader.
- Applications signed online can no longer be edited after a **digital ID** has been added. If you would like to change the data, you must delete the signature (right-click on the signature field and select "delete signature").
- For security reasons, please only submit the forms by email using your student email account provided by the Computer Center.

## **Digital ID:**

A digital ID should be used for the digital signature. You can add a digital ID to Foxit as follows:

- 1. Go to the tab "Protect"
- 2. Select "Sign & Certify"
- 3. Click "Digital IDs", then "Add Digital ID" and enter your email address, assign a password and save.
- 4. The digital ID is saved locally on your desktop as a pfx file.

Adobe handles digital IDs similarly.

# Simple online signature:

Inserting a scan of your signature (image data: Bmp, Gif, Tif, Jpg, Png, Ppm) or creating and inserting the signature with the **Foxit eSign** tab changes the PDF form and the next recipient can no longer edit the form's fields. Adobe even displays an error message letting you know that adding a signature means that the other fields can no longer be edited. **For this reason**, please <u>do not use</u> this signature for applications which need to be forwarded to further recipients.

#### Certified online signature:

If you have a certified online signature, you may use it.

## Submitting a form with an original signature by post or email:

Alternatively you can print out your application, sign it by hand and email a scan to pa.chemie@ur.de or send it by post (link to the address of the examinations office).
