

Sustainability Award 2025

Background. At the University of Regensburg, sustainability, as defined by the "[Sustainability Strategy 2023–2027](#)," is a key concern and cross-cutting theme that affects all university fields of action (research, teaching, student engagement, campus operations, digitalization, knowledge transfer, and governance) and addresses all seventeen Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations.

To recognize and highlight commitment and progress on the path to greater sustainability, and to support exemplary initiatives and projects, the University of Regensburg has been awarding an annual Sustainability Award since 2024. The prize is awarded by the University of Regensburg's Executive Board.

The award recognizes innovative projects, structural measures, special activities, or outstanding achievements by individuals or groups that significantly advance the University of Regensburg's efforts to strengthen sustainability in at least one of the university's fields of action.

Prize Money. The Sustainability Award is rewarded with €5,000.00. On the one hand, already completed or ongoing projects, measures, or achievements can be submitted, and on the other hand, specific ideas and projects to be implemented in the future can also be recognized. In all cases, the prize money must be used for measures in line with the "Sustainability Strategy 2023-2027." The funds are distributed through the Green Office, which reports on implemented projects to the university's "Sustainability Council for the Future" at least once a year.

Application. Applications can be submitted electronically by June 30, 2025:

Applications are open to any member of the UR. Several members of the UR as a group, accredited initiatives, and organizational units can also apply. Self-nominations are expressly possible and encouraged. Candidates can also be nominated.

Applications must be submitted digitally via the SoSci-Survey-Tool and must include information on the project and the contact person. This includes information on the working title, a brief description of the project, at least one associated field of action, the added value for the sustainable transformation process at UR, and the envisioned use of the prize money. Publications or other types of supporting material can also be attached in a single PDF document.

A simultaneous application for other prizes is possible but must be declared when submitting the application.

Selection process. The prize is awarded by a majority decision by a selection committee consisting of (i) the University's Sustainability Officer, (ii) a member of the Green Office and (iii) three members appointed by the Sustainability Council of the Future from among its members (at least one of whom should be a student member); with a list of potential replacements. The prize can also be divided among several applications, and non-endowed recognition prizes are also possible. There may also be a decision not to award the prize. Information on the outcome of the selection process will be provided by the end of September at the latest.

Award Ceremony. The award ceremony will take place as part of a celebratory event on Thursday evening, November 6, 2025.
